

HEAVY VEHICLE CLASS 5 COURSE INFORMATION SHEET

Class 5 Heavy Trailer Licence – Trucks more than 25,000kg

The Class 5 Licence covers Heavy Combination Vehicles with a Gross Combined Weight of more than 25,000kg.

You must have held a Class 4 Full Licence for at least six months before you can apply for a Class 5 Learner Licence.

To attend one of our Class 5 courses you **MUST** hold a Class 5 Learner Licence.

Because PassRite Driving Academy Ltd has the necessary NZQA and NZ Transport Agency approvals, completing any of our training programmes means you are able to **bypass any waiting period on the Learners Licence** and gain your full licence immediately upon successful completion of our training programme.

Upon successful completion of your training programme you will be issued with a NZ Transport Agency certificate, which you can take to any NZ Transport Agency approved Driver Licensing Agency (AA or VTNZ) to have your Licence upgraded to a Full Class 5 Licence with no other tests required.

Already Hold Logbooks

- If course requirements relating to unit standard 24089 were successfully completed within 12 months of the current course – there is no requirement to complete training or assessment
- If course requirements for 24089 were successfully completed more than 12 months prior to the current course – PassRite shall confirm that the trainee has retained the knowledge and skills to be competent in this unit
 - Either by:
 - PassRite reviewing 7 days of logbook pages completed by the trainee within the preceding 12 months or
 - The trainee completing any one of the approved course logbook scenarios
 - In confirming competency in either of the above, the required standard is that all completed logbook pages satisfy legal requirements

Option 1 For Students that DON'T hold a Class 5 Learner Licence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You must have held a current NZ Class 4 Full Licence for a minimum of <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Over 25: Three months Under 25: Six months Obtain a medical certificate, completed on a DL9 form – provided by doctor or GP (If you have already done a medical and lodged it with AA or VTNZ within 5 years this is not required again) Obtain a NZ Class 5 Learner Licence from AA or VTNZ (Approved Driver Licensing Agency) Booking prior to attending your course (Bookings are only accepted once you have obtained a NZ Class 5 Learner Licence)
Option 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> MUST hold a current NZ Class 5 Learner License Booking prior to attending your course (Bookings are only accepted once you have obtained a NZ Class 5 Learner Licence)
